New AED Installed at Roma

On March 7th Jason Caira of the South Shore Fire Department, and a member of Roma Lodge, conducted a CPR training class in Vittoria Hall. Using instructional videos, mannequins and automated external defibrillator (AED) simulators, Jason provided excellent instruction regarding exactly what to do in an emergency. Participants practiced proper CPR techniques and how to use Roma's in-house AED. These potentially life saving techniques are essential to know in the event of an emergency.

Last Month, Jason, with the help of Lieutenant Scott Brauer of the South Shore Fire Department, installed a new automated external defibrillator (AED) just outside the Venetian Room. The new equipment was purchased through a grant from the All Saints Foundation. Jason wrote the grant due to the previous Roma Lodge AED being outdated and in need of expensive service.

Some members may recall that when All Saints originally launched the program to provide AED equipment, Roma Lodge was the first organization in the community to have successfully save a life using the AED.

Big thank you to Jason for his efforts to educate and keep our emergency equipment up-to-date.
