## **MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT**

The next Roma Lodge members' meeting is Friday, June 9, 7:00 pm. It's a social meeting, and member's wives or significant others are welcome to attend with you. Zuddy's famous pizza will be a featured special on Thursday nights - buy one/get one free for those who dine in, and buy one/get one ½ off carry-out.

Java By Drew Estate Maduro Robusto (5"x 50) is a smooth to medium-bodied, small batch production of first-rate Nicaraguan long fillers and binder, uniquely infused with the rich, creamy flavors of coffee.

### **ALEC BRADLEY THE LINEAGE 665 - \$9.99**

Alec Bradley Lineage 1996 cigars are the 'next generation' of their bestselling Family Blend series. This line was made to commemorate company prez Alan Rubin's sons, Alec & Bradley, who became of legal smoking age in 2014.
