

Four of the Six Proposed By-Law Changes Passes. Results Below.

BALLOT

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES – SEPT 14, 2018 – RESULTS OF VOTE

Passage requires 2/3 majority of those voting OR 2/3 of 77 total votes OR 51 votes or higher

- 56__ YES __22__ NO **By-Law Change 1 – PASSED**
Section 1: Any man may apply for adult membership in accordance with the established procedures of the organization if the following qualifications are met:
ADD F. He submits the results of genetic testing that show Italian ancestry
- 65__ YES 11 __ NO **By-Law Change 2 - PASSED**
The President is the highest-ranking member of the lodge. As the leader of the lodge, his duties are to:
B. See that the laws of the Lodge are observed and that **ADD the By-laws** and the deliberations of the Board and the General Membership are carried out.
- 62__ YES 16 __ NO **Article VI: Section 11: Parliamentarian - PASSED**
The Parliamentarian gives opinions concerning the application and interpretation of the By-laws and rules of the Lodge **DELETE: ~~and sees that they are observed and properly applied.~~**
ADD: He shall be responsible for compiling and maintaining the most current By-laws of Roma Lodge and the Rules of the Lodge. He will make them available to members upon request.
- 43__ YES 35 --- NO **Article VI Section 12 - FAILED**
A. To take and record the minutes of all meetings of the Board and the General Membership.
i) *The minutes of the Board of Directors shall be read for approval and corrections at the next successive Board of Directors meeting.*
ii) *The minutes of the General Membership Meeting will be available to the Membership at the next successive Membership meeting and approved upon a motion requested by the President, but Minutes will read only upon a motion made by a member and passed by the membership in attendance.*
- 36__ YES 42__ NO **By-Law Change 4**
Article V: Membership Regulations - FAILED
Section 17: In the event an officer or director is absent from three (3) Board meetings **ADD or Membership Meetings** between March 1st and February 28th of the next calendar year, the Board must decide whether that officer or director should be removed from office.
- 62__ YES 16 --- NO_ **By-Law Change 5 - PASSED**
Article VI: Organization
Section 9: Board Committees
The President is the highest-ranking officer of the lodge. As the leader of the Lodge, his duties are to:
E. Subject to majority approval of the Board, appoint the members of the Board as chairmen of the Lodge Standing Committees:

as well as chairmen of all committees of the Lodge (unless the laws of the Lodge provide otherwise). He shall be an *ex-officio* member of all such committees, except the Nominations and Elections Committee. (Amended December 4, 2009)
