Roma Lodge Members:

A sign that summer is not too far off is that baseball season is upon us, and the NBA playoffs are around the corner. Once again this year, when the members' bar is open, those who are watching the Brewers game in the bar will receive a free "Roma special" shot with each Brewer home run!
