

## Blind Bogey Strategies

### Blind Bogey: Total Score for Round

Format: Random Selection

Event Hole Costs	
9 Holes	18 Holes
\$3.00	\$5.00

Rule: Prior to playing the round a number is randomly selected between the course par for both 9 holes and 18 holes and an arbitrary number selected by a phone app determines the winning score (i.e. 80 for 9 holes and 100 for 18 holes).

At the end of the round (9 or 18 holes depending on the golfer's choice), the golfer's score getting closest to that number for their round wins the prize. There will be one winner for 9 holes and one for 18 holes. If everyone plays 9 holes or 18 holes, there will only be one winner.

### Blind Bogey: Closest to Pin and Longest Putt

Format: Holes will be designated prior to the round for each bogey type (i.e. White Course: par 3 holes 2 and 8 will be closest to the pin, hole 9 will be longest putt).

Rule: Golfer that either lands closest to the pin and/or has the longest putt for the designated hole will win the prize. Don Cicero has markers he said we could use.

### Blind Bogey: Luck-of-the-draw

Format/Rule: The name of each golfer participating in the day's league event will be put in a container and a name will be drawn at dinner/lunch by a member to determine the winner.
